Landmark project nears completion

Harrow Council and its contractor partner, EnterpriseMouchel, are currently carrying out highway improvement works for the Petts Hill Bridge and Highway Improvement Scheme.

EnterpriseMouchel is constructing new carriageways, kerbs, cycleways and footways at the site, while extensive utility works are being carried out to renew old plant equipment and services.

Unfortunately the project has been delayed by more than a month due to severe winter conditions.

Major works are set to be completed by mid February, with minor works – including the completion of the coloured surfaces, cycle tracks and light columns – following on until late March.

Harrow Council and EnterpriseMouchel

In July 2006, EnterpriseMouchel was appointed as a long-term partner for Harrow Council, consolidating infrastructure works previously carried out by more than 20 different contractors across the borough.

As part of the Partnership, EnterpriseMouchel – a highway management and maintenance company that is equally owned by Enterprise and Mouchel – was awarded a five-year, £100 million infrastructure works' package.

The Partnership is responsible for a wide range of areas across the borough – including 450km of roads; 900km of pavements; 19,000 street lights and columns; 30,000 street furniture items such as road signs, bins and bollards; 19,000 roadside drainage gullies; 72km of watercourse; 43 river structures; 117 structures including bridges, footbridges and subways; 18 public car parks; winter maintenance of 290km of main roads; and all bus routes.
