Petts Hill Bridge and Highway Improvement Scheme

As you may be aware, Harrow Council and Ealing Council are working with their partners Transport for London, Network Rail, EnterpriseMouchel and Birse Rail to deliver improvements to Petts Hill Bridge and the surrounding highway.

We would like to provide you with a further update on the scheme.

Harrow Council and its partner EnterpriseMouchel will begin major highway works in the next month on the Ealing side of the new Petts Hill Bridge site, improving pedestrian crossing facilities, cycle tracks and footpaths.

Further highway works are planned for later in the year, which will involve creating a short section of bus lane; widening the carriageway to two lanes in each direction; and enhancing links to Northolt Park Station.

The works follow on from the Christmas installation of the new 270-tonne railway bridge, for which an opening ceremony will be held on Tuesday 21 April, from 11.45am at the Petts Hill junction with The Heights.

HRH The Duke of Gloucester, who previously visited Harrow in June 2005 for the 60th Anniversary for the end of World War Two, will unveil a commemorative plaque at the event.

Thank you in advance for your continued support and patience as we continue to deliver improvements to the transport network.
