Re: Petts Hill Bridge and Highway Improvement Works - Road Closures

As you are aware, Harrow Council and its contractor partner, EnterpriseMouchel, are currently carrying out highway improvement works for the Petts Hill Bridge and Highway Improvement Scheme.

EnterpriseMouchel are constructing new carriageways, kerbs, cycleways and footways at the site, while utility works are to be carried out by BT.

Although substantial completion is expected before Christmas, other works are set to be finalised in the New Year. This will require some temporary traffic restrictions to be put into place.

Currently some drivers are using the Alexandra Avenue service road as a "rat-run" to turn around – causing disruption to this particular section of the road's residents. In order to prevent this, we will try to deter non-residential traffic from entering the road.

This restriction will be in place from 7.30am -10.30am, from the morning of 9 December to the morning of 11 January. Please note that residents who live in the Alexandra Avenue service road will still be allowed access.

A further restriction will also be introduced at The Heights, to allow EnterpriseMouchel to construct a large speed cushion or entry table. Access to the road from Petts Hill will be fully closed from the morning of 14 December to the morning of 11 January. We encourage residents, who need to access The Heights from the Petts Hill end during this period, to enter via the Racecourse Estate or Eastcote Lane North.
